- Utility B, Utility A
- Open ODX B/A, Open CDX B/A
- Novice B, Novice A, Novice C - Novice group exercises will be held after the individual exercises and may be combined)
- Beginner Novice B, Beginner Novice A (Optional Titling Class)

**Obedience Ribbons:** 1st thru 4th place and green qualifying or x qualifying ribbons will be awarded when applicable. Rosettes will be given for HIT, High Combined, HIT Aussie, HIT Other Breed and HIT Junior Handler. Dogs must receive a qualifying score to receive a ribbon. New title ribbons awarded to all dogs completing titles in Rally or Obedience.

ASCA<sup>®</sup> Performance Titles. A Tracking number is required for obedience/rally competition. Rules and forms can be found at <https://asca.org/asca/business-office/rules-forms/>. A dog will be allowed to be shown at the trial where the handler applies for an ASCA<sup>®</sup> tracking number. No dog without an ASCA<sup>®</sup> individual registration, LEP number or ASCA<sup>®</sup> tracking number may compete in any ASCA<sup>®</sup> Obedience Trial.

### ATTENTION EXHIBITORS: CASC RULES AND REGULATIONS

- These shows will be judged and run by the Show Rules of the Australian Shepherd Club of America.
- All entries must be complete (with agreement signed) or they will be refused. All dogs must have ASCA registration or tracking number on entry form. Entries must be on the current ASCA entry form.
- Incorrect and/or missing information will invalidate entries.
- Judges may be substituted.
- Bitches in Season will not be allowed to compete in this trial or be in the building. Upon verification of being in heat by a veterinarian or the trial committee, the entry fee will be refunded.
- There will be no food vendor at these shows.
- No electrical and/or mechanical training devices will be permitted on the show grounds.
- Set up may begin at 8:00 am on Saturday and Sunday, and all exhibitors and club members must be off premises by one-half hour after completion of second trial each day.
- Neither the facility nor the club nor the chairman will be responsible or obligated to furnish any services for notifying exhibitors or their agents of class judging. Cascade ASC and Baywind Australian Shepherds will not be held responsible for any missing or lost items.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. **Entry fees will only be refunded if the refund request is received before the pre-entry closing date.** Substitutions allowed with dogs that you own or co-own. ·No entry fee will be refunded if the show cannot be opened or completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Acts of God, or public emergency.
- Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or guests and family members. Any Exhibitor whose dog and/or guests/family members create an unnecessary disturbance or engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the direction of the trial committee or CASC board member, be asked to leave the show site. In such case no refund of any entry fees will be made. The facility, show-giving club, the Show Chairman, their agents, officers and/or committee assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to spectators.
- All dogs must be on leash or confined to a crate except while in the ring during competition. Dogs must be on leash to and from parking area to show ring.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after your dogs. Failure to do so will result in excusal from trial and forfeiture of entry fees.
- No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA obedience or rally program, a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs and a person not in good standing with ASCA.
- For the safety of your dogs and others, all dogs must have current vaccinations against rabies. You are asked to bring a copy of the rabies certificate with you.

**Covid-19 related information:** The show ring is indoors, in a climate-controlled building.

- Current masking guidelines will be followed at the time of the show.
- If you have not been vaccinated, we ask that you respect and practice the current suggested protocols.
- The show committee has the right to ask any person to leave the show area.

**-This is a private residence, please only use the designated potty area.**

**-PLEASE do not park on the lawn. Due to limited parking, please try to carpool. Someone will help you park so that you do not block others coming and going. Thank you!**

### Directions to Baywind Australian Shepherds:

20804 NE 40<sup>th</sup> Ave, Ridgefield, WA 98642

From I-5 South, take the 179<sup>th</sup> St exit #9, go North on 10<sup>th</sup> Ave for 1 mile and turn right on 199<sup>th</sup> St. Go approx. 1.5 miles and turn left on NE 40<sup>th</sup> Ave (across from Pioneer Grange). Go to the end of the road past the mailboxes (90 degree left turn) and it is the last house at the end of the road. You will see the Aussie on the open gate.

From I-5 North, take exit #11, go East on SR502 towards Battle Ground (stay in right lane). Turn right on 10<sup>th</sup> Ave (first light) for 1 mile and turn left on 199<sup>th</sup> St. Go approx. 1.5 miles and turn left on NE 40<sup>th</sup> Ave (across from Pioneer Grange). Go to the end of the road past the mailboxes (90 degree left turn) and it is the last house at the end of the road. You will see the Aussie on the open gate.
