Day-of-Show (*refundable at Show Secretary's discretion*): **Reg: **\$22.00**; Jr's: **\$5.00**

(*Entrants competing with the same dog in Masters & Excellent in the same trial pay \$5 LESS for the 2nd entry)

Class run order may be changed at Judge's discretion. There will not be any FEO at these trials.

Awards/Ribbons: 1st thru 4th place, plus green qualifying and x qualifying flat ribbons will be awarded. Rosettes will be given for HIT, High Combined, HIT Aussie, HIT Other Breed and HIT Junior Handler. Dogs must receive a qualifying score to receive a ribbon.

ASCA® Performance Titles. A Tracking number is required for rally competition. Rules and forms can be found at <http://www.asca.org/formsandrulebooks>. A dog will be allowed to be shown at the trial where the handler applies for an ASCA® tracking number. The rate will be a one time fee of \$10.00 per dog + a \$10.00 fee for a service membership. A dog without an ASCA® individual registration, LEP number or ASCA® tracking number may not compete in any ASCA® Rally Trial.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

These shows will be judged and run by the Show Rules of the Australian Shepherd Club of America.

These Shows are held indoors on dirt floors in an unheated agility barn. There will be no food vendor at these shows.

No electrical and/or mechanical training devices will be permitted on the show grounds.

Set up may begin at 7:30 am, and all exhibitors and club members must be off premises by sundown.

Neither the facility nor the club nor the chairman will be responsible or obligated to furnish any services for notifying exhibitors or their agents of class judging. Cascade ASC or Brigands Hideout will not be held responsible for any missing or lost items.

Incorrect and/or missing information will invalidate entries.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. Entry fees will only be refunded if the refund request is received before the pre-entry closing date.

Substitutions allowed with dogs that you own or co-own. No entry fee will be refunded if the show cannot be opened or completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Acts of God, or public emergency.

The facility, show-giving club, the Show Chairmen, their agents, officers, and/or committee shall assume no responsibility for injury to children.

Judges may be substituted.

Handler is responsible for his/her dog and must keep the dog under his control at all times. Handler will be responsible for any injury caused by their actions or that of their dog. All dogs must be on leash or confined to a crate/x-pen at all times except while in the ring during competition. Dogs must be on leash to and from parking area to show ring.

Please clean up after your dogs.

No bitches in season in the building! No bitches in season allowed to compete.

For the safety of your dogs and others, all dogs must have current vaccinations against rabies. You are asked to bring a copy of the rabies certificate with you.

Take Exit 7 toward NE 134th St./East/West/WSU Vancouver

Turn east onto NE 134th St., continue on NE Salmon Creek Ave., Turn left onto NE 50th Ave. Go approx. half a mile, turn right onto NE 159th St. In approximately 2 miles turn right onto NE 92nd Ave. Continue on NE 92nd Ave., which becomes 156th St. until you see signs for Brigand's Hideout on your left.

Come through main driveway, 2nd gate, to set up. You may park to load and unload only, then move your vehicle to back parking lot.
